- Third party payment processors (money service business)
- Medicinal or recreational cannabis sales (including hemp)
- Embassies and foreign consulates
- Adult entertainment establishments
- Psilocybin and other federally controlled schedule 1 substance sales
- · Foreign exchange houses
- Gambling businesses
- Pouch activity (negotiable instrument/currency courier services)
- Private banking
- Foreign correspondent accounts
- Privately owned ATMs
- Politically exposed persons (PEP)
